### Refreshments for your breaks

#### Eco coffee break

Coffee, tea, orange juice, croissants

#### Traditional coffee break *(included in the conference package)*

We serve freshly baked croissants, biscuits and cakes in the morning, and mini-sandwiches and Danish pastries in the afternoon; these are always accompanied by a well-stocked fruit basket.

In the morning we serve fresh butter and wholegrain croissants, biscuits, cakes and a varied selection of fruit. In the afternoon we offer mini-sandwiches, Danish pastries and pieces of fruit; a selection of vegetable matchsticks and dips is available on both occasions.

#### Fitness break

In the morning we serve fresh wholegrain croissants, a selection of granary rolls with cottage cheese, tomatoes and juicy ham. #### Graubünden delight

In the morning we serve fresh butter croissants, a selection of rolls with alpine cheese from Davos and Graubünden air-dried beef, followed by walnut tart from a local bakery. In the afternoon we offer baguettes with Davoser Mutschli (hard cheese), Graubünden dry-cured sausage and pear bread. Pieces of fruit and a selection of vegetable matchsticks and dips are available on both occasions.
